#### WARRANTY


This heating pad is warranted against defective material or workmanship from the date of purchase. This unit's warranty length is: 4 years.

Many safety checks are built into the control for your safety. If the pad finds a safety issue, the power is terminated to the pad and the LCD will display an "EE" message. To reset the unit, remove the plug from the outlet and plug it back in. If the unsafe condition continues to exist, the control will again go into safety mode, all power will be cut off, and the LCD will display an "EE" message. If repeated attempts continue to produce an "EE" message, please email customer service info@caraincorporated.com.

Any defective part will be repaired or replaced at no charge as long as it has not been repaired or tampered with and was used according to these printed instructions. Any charges incurred to ship the product back for replacement are the sole responsibility of the consumer This warranty gives you specific legal rights as well as other rights, which vary from state to state.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Powering ON

Make sure pad connector and controller connector are properly engaged. Plug controller into 120VAC, 60 Hz electrical outlet. Above the LCD, the top LED will turn on, indicating unit is connected and ready for use. The controller operates 4 push-buttons. Press **POWER button (B1)** once the controller is connected to a household electrical outlet.

#### **Selecting Temperature Settings**

The LCD will display the temperature setting retained from the previous session. A thermometer icon bar graph indicates the temperature mode. Use the **UP button (B2)** and **DOWN button (B3)** to select the temperature setting (110°F, 120°F, 130°F, 140°F, 150°F, 160°F). The display shows progress as the pad temperature changes, Use UP and DOWN buttons at any time to adjust the temperature setting.

#### Selecting Auto Shut-off Times

Press **MODE button (B4)** to set the Auto Shut-off time. A clock icon will indicate the time mode. Use UP and DOWN buttons to select desired Auto Shut-off time setting (30 or 60 minutes). Use UP and DOWN buttons at any time to adjust the time setting. In a few seconds the display returns to the temperature mode.

You may press MODE button to see the remaining minutes left of your selection. Press MODE button again to return to the temperature mode right away. During the last two minutes of the Auto Shut-off, the display goes into the time mode automatically, and remains in that mode up to the end of the session.

#### **Powering OFF**

To restart the pad at any time, press POWER button to turn the pad off and then press POWER button again to turn the pad on The Auto Shut-off timer resets. Be sure to disconnect from power source unit after use. **Never leave a connected unit unattended.** 

#### **Dry Heat Therapy**

- Plug the power cord into a 120VAC, 60 Hz electrical outlet.
- 2. Set the controller to desired settings
- 3. Place the pad on the area needing heat.
- Press the OFF button and unplug power cord when finished.

### **Moist Heat Therapy**

- Insert the pad into the cloth cover without the sponge
- Saturate the sponge with warm water and wring out any excess.
- 3. Place the sponge on the heating pad inside the cloth cover.
- Plug the power cord into a 120VAC, 60 Hz electrical outlet.
- 5. Set controller to desired settings.
- Press the OFF button and unplug power cord when finished.

# **WASHING INSTRUCTIONS**

# DO NOT DRY CLEAN! DO NOT USE BLEACH! DO NOT USE WRINGER! DO NOT IRON YOUR HEATING PAD!

- 1. Set controller to OFF and unplug pad from wall outlet.
- Disconnect power cord. **DO NOT** pull by the cord.
- Disengage pad/controller connector.
- Machine wash pad in warm water on gentle cycle; tumble dry on medium heat. Remove promptly from the dryer. Or hand wash in warm water and line dry.
- . **DO NOT** plug in pad until it is dry.

#### **Automatic Shut-Off**

Your heating pad is equipped with a special safety feature designed to shut the heating pad off after 30 or 60 minutes of use. When the automatic shut-off feature turns the pad off, the LCD on the controller turns off to let you know the pad has shut off. To restart the pad, just reselect the On/Off button.
